Dr. Keil was awarded the Lifetime Achievement Award for recognition of his contributions to AFE and UW-Stout.

AFE Twin Cities Chapter 13 offers scholarships to students in the UW-Stout Facilities program. These scholarships are administered by the UW-Stout University Foundation. The foundation also selects the students to receive the scholarships. This fall two scholarships were awarded.

Student Chapter 256 from Century College is the second student chapter supported by AFE Twin Cities Chapter 13. Century College, located in White Bear Lake, MN offers facilities degree programs in Engineering, Engineering CAD Technology, Facility Systems Technology, and Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning Technology.
